☼ Organic Ur Pils, <u>Brauerei Pinkus</u> , Germany <i>Fresh, sweet grain flavors are tempered by a touch of crisp, hoppy bitterness</i> 5.2%	\$9
Ebel's Weiss, <u>Two Brothers</u> , Warrenville, IL <i>Wonderful malt sweetness and a soft aroma of clove, vanilla, and banana.</i> 4.9%	\$5
Domaine DuPage French Country Ale, <u>Two Brothers</u> , Warrenville, IL <i>Deep amber ale with a toasty and sweet caramel start. Slightly hoppy.</i> 5.9%	\$5
Tripel Karmeliet, Tripel Ale, <u>Brouwerij Bosteels</u> , Belgium <i>A robust, smooth, & fruity blonde; three-grain top-fermented beer</i> 8%	\$10
