ABSINTHES ET PASTIS

Pernod Pastis – The classic pastis from France, containing coriander, star anise and mint	8
Ricard Pastis de Marseilles - Marseilles answer to Pernod. Best served with water and ice	8
North Shore “Sirène” Absinthe Verte - Rich & complex, using the traditional trinity of absinthe ingredients along with a blend of additional herbs and spices	12
La Muse Verte Absinthe - Fresh, herbal aroma with hints of grass, licorice and citrus. A coating texture that has notes of apples, herbs, peppermint & sandalwood, and ends with a spicy touch.	12
Vieux Pontarlier Absinthe Francais Superieure - Aromas of bright anise and alpine herb notes with savory, lightly mentholated hints of wormwood. The initial taste is spicily piquant and herbal with a refreshing, cooling finish of anise & fennel seed.	13
